| 5pm    | Cocktails / Hors d'oeuvres                                                               | Lets guests arrive, settle in, mingle amongst each other, and allows time for the wedding party to finish photo's, arrive at the reception, and get situated for the reception.                                                                                                                                                                                              |
| 5:30pm | Wedding Party Introduction / Parents                                                     | Lets the guests know who is in the wedding in honor of the bride and groom. Introductions include the wedding party, ushers, parents, etc.                                                                                                                                                                                                                                   |
| 5:45pm | Welcome / Prayer                                                                         | After everyone is settle in their seats, a welcome or thank you announcement can be made to make everyone feel appreciated and welcomed. This can be a time to pray before dinner.                                                                                                                                                                                           |
| 6pm    | Dinner                                                                                   | Yummy! 45 min or longer; usually the wedding party is served first or begins the buffet line. Time depends on how many guests are present and how much time the bride and groom would like to enjoy their meal.                                                                                                                                                              |
| 6:45pm | Toasts / Speeches                                                                        | This is an opportunity for the Best Man and Maid of Honor to speak as well as anyone else designated to speak. This is a time to cherish the bonding of the bride and groom as the newly married couple.                                                                                                                                                                     |
| 7pm    | <u>Highlight Dances</u><br>First Dance<br>Father/Daughter<br>Mother/Son<br>Wedding Party | These sentimental dances are recommended to be done as close to after dinner as possible to ensure everyone gets to enjoy the special moments the bride and groom have with each other, their parents, and wedding party. The later the evening gets, the more likely guests will need to head home. No one wants to miss these important dances!                            |
| 7:30pm | Cake Cutting                                                                             | Cutting the cake after the Highlight Dances helps keep guests at the reception! After cutting the cake, guests usually begin to say their goodbyes. It also gives dinner time to digest so everyone can enjoy the cake.                                                                                                                                                      |
| 7:45pm | <u>Tribute Dances</u><br>Dollar Dance<br>Anniversary Dance                               | The tribute dances are a celebratory way to welcome the bride and groom into wedded bliss. Examples include the dollar dance – helping them get on their feet as a new couple and shows support for their future, and the anniversary dance – identifying the fantastic couples over the years, usually ending with the newest couple and oldest couple!                     |

Discharging the boquet and garter into a crowd of unmarried passes on good luck to the next to be wed.
